The CRAM Program offered me the Pre and Post award courses, which provided me with a fluency in policies and procedures at the frontline of our graduate school that facilitates further grant/scholarship administration and therefore high caliber research- with an eye toward fulfill the responsibilities of the Scholarship Chairperson. The AWIS GCH will give me the opportunity to work on career advancement and simultaneously contribute to my community through science outreach. If elected, I aim to further AWIS GCH's mission by increasing opportunities for the members to network with STEM professional

mentors in diverse careers.
